RE: The voter registration deadline for the August Primary Election is Tuesday, July 14th!

Shawnee County Election Commissioner Andrew Howell is reminding Shawnee County voters to ensure their voter registration is current and up-to-date before the voter registration deadline. **The deadline to register to vote in the Primary Election is next Tuesday, July 14th.**

The provisional voting process is truly a safety net for voters and their votes. However, the very best way to not need this safety net is to ensure that your voter registration is accurate prior to the voter registration deadline (close of business on Tuesday, July 14, 2020) [KSA 25-2311].
