DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Duration: 1 hour +

Overview of the dynamics and definitions of domestic violence, how to recognize and respond to these dynamics, the particular dangers victim-survivors face in domestic violence relationships and how to support a victim-survivor

NEUROBIOLOGY OF TRAUMA

Duration: 1-3 hours (adaptable length)

Understanding the physical, neuro-biological response to trauma. Explore how trauma affects the brain's ability to send signals to the body, the storage of memory and the impact to the individual's behavior

Duration: 30 minutes - 1 hour

HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Duration: 1 hour +

Overview of the dynamics and definitions of human trafficking, the impact on our culture and our community, identify the signs of human trafficking and potential responses to suspected victim-survivors of trafficking

SEXUAL VIOLENCE

Duration: 1 hour +

Overview of the dynamics and definitions of sexual violence, identify the influences of rape culture, discuss consent, and debunk common myths surrounding sexual violence and rape
