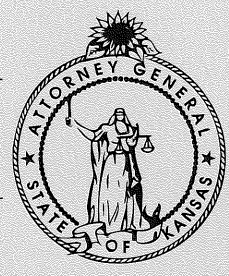


# Protect your identity.
