Shawnee County Health Department to Begin Offering COVID-19 Pfizer-BioNTech Pediatric Vaccine Today by Appointment

Topeka, Kan. – Following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s (CDC) Advisory Committee for Immunization Practice (ACIP) vote on November 2, 2021 to recommend the Pediatric Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine for emergency use authorization the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) authorized all COVID-19 vaccine providers in Kansas to begin administering vaccine starting November 3, 2021 to children ages 5 to 11 following guidance received from the CDC.

Starting today, Thursday November 4, 2021 the Shawnee County Health Department (SCHD) will begin offering the Pfizer-BioNTech pediatric vaccine, in addition to other vaccines, at their Clinical Services Division, located at 2115 SW 10th Ave, by appointment only.
