



Has the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic caused drinking and wastewater bills to go unpaid?

Financial assistance is available.

Details:

Eligible Kansas households combined income must be **equal to or less than 150 percent** of Federal Poverty Level, which equals \$3,313 a month for a family of four.

The Emergency Water Assistance Program (EWAP) **provides payments to restore or prevent disconnection** of drinking water and wastewater services

EWAP is a separate benefit from LIEAP

Funding available: **\$9 million**

DCF will accept applications until funding is depleted.

Emergency Water Assistance Program (EWAP)

Authorized by the American Rescue Plan of 2021 and the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021, qualifying Kansas households may have drinking water and wastewater service reconnected or prevented from being disconnected.


DCF will accept applications and coordinate payment on behalf of eligible households.
