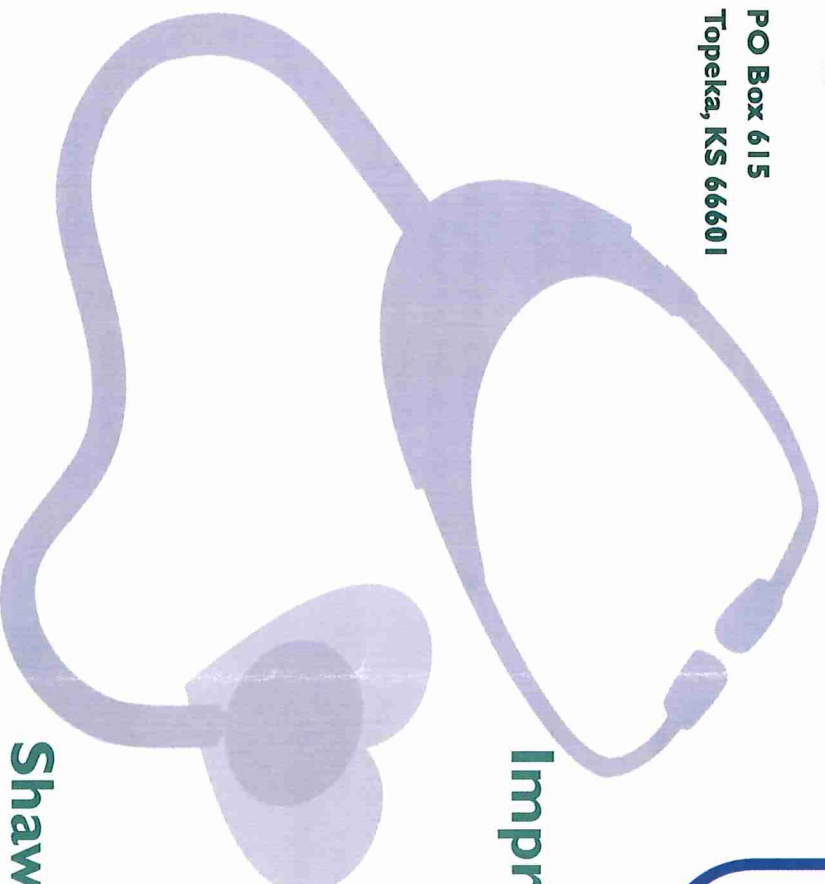

The HealthAccess program is designed to complement and enhance the work of existing low-income clinics and partners. By focusing on preventive care, rather than emergency care, patients find a 'medical home' once they are enrolled in our program.

HealthAccess combines donated provider care, dental care, hospital services, and medication assistance.



SERVICES DONATED

Health services are donated by providers that are medically necessary, which are determined by your health care provider.

These services may include: office visits, regular checkups, hospital-based services, inpatient and/or outpatient services, and lab and x-ray services.

Referrals for specialty care are required to come from your primary care provider and prior notification of HealthAccess is required.

HealthAccess does not include: inpatient psychiatric services, pregnancy related services, emergency room expenses or ambulance services

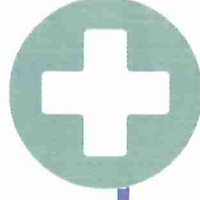

ELIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for HealthAccess, you must:

- ▶ Live in, or have residency in Shawnee County
- ▶ Have a family income that is 150% or below Federal Poverty Guidelines
- ▶ Not be receiving Medicare, Medicaid, or state/federal medical benefits
- ▶ Establish with a primary care provider that participates in HealthAccess
Call the HealthAccess office for assistance establishing with a primary care provider.

If you meet qualifications and are enrolled in the HealthAccess program, you will receive access to most generic prescriptions. There is a 12-month maximum coverage of \$1,000 and/or \$200 per prescription. A minimal co-pay per prescription will be required.



PLEASE REMEMBER

Doctors, area clinics, pharmacists, hospitals and many others are donating their services to help you get well and stay well. They are not being paid for the services provided to you.

HealthAccess is not a government program, or other entitlement program. The donated care may end at any time, for any reason.

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants must complete the New Patient application, and sign all required pages. Applications must be submitted with the households last four weeks of income (paycheck stubs, unemployment, SSI/SSD benefits). If there is no income, submit a letter of support signed by the person and/or agency providing support (parent/friend/Let's Help/ Section 8/etc.
