

What is microtransit?

Microtransit is "flexible transit." It uses mobile technology to offer trips on-demand within specific zones. It is similar to Uber and Lyft but is operated by public transit. Microtransit is more flexible than rigid fixed routes and paratransit and uses smaller, more nimble vehicles.



On-Demand Transportation

MOD (Metro on Demand) service is expected to begin in southeast Topeka in late January, 2023. Utilizing the MOD app on a smartphone or computer, or by phone, passengers can book a ride for travel within a single zone (see below). Within approximately 15 minutes one of our professionally-trained drivers will arrive for pick-up and continue to the requested destination. Passengers can access residential and commercial locations, or even connect with a fixed route bus for travel outside the defined zones.

Hours of MOD operation will be Monday through Friday from 5:35am to 6:40pm, and Saturday from 8:15am to 6:40pm. Fees for this shared ride program will be \$2 for a one-way ride. Reduced Fare and youth pricing options are available.
